The Venue

This event is being held at FactoruM, an amazing venue comprised of sofas, outdoor seating, 35 gaming tables and a super friendly and welcoming staff.

There is free on-site parking. However, when the car park in front of the venue is full, customers must use the overflow car park at the entrance to the trading estate. You must not park on the grass, or at the front of other businesses on the estate!

Food

FactoruM is equipped with a kitchen capable of cooking all kinds of hot food, freshly prepared by their chef. FactoruM is credited with a 5 star hygiene certificate.

Hot breakfasts are available to order on arrival. FactoruM serves Full English breakfasts and various hot baps, catering to different dietary preferences.

All kinds of hot food is available for lunch and dinner. From burgers, pizza, hot dogs and steak, there is something for everyone and all of it divine.

If you have any dietary requirements, you must speak to FactoruM, who can advise you on the ingredients and prepping procedures of their meals.

Tickets

There are 40 tickets available for this tournament. Tickets are priced at £40. Ticket sales are non-refundable from 1 week before the event and ticket sales end on the list submission deadline date.

FactoruM Full Members

FactoruM Full Members are able to purchase their tickets for £35. Full Members must bring a valid membership ID with them to gain entry to the venue. Valid forms of ID include: A membership tag, dated for the date of the event, Military ID, Veterans ID, and Blue Light Cards.

Failure to bring membership ID will invalidate your ticket, unless you purchase a new membership from FactoruM on the day.

Friends of FactoruM

FactoruM charges Ginger Odin Miniature Wargaming for table hire for their events. This fee is waived for each player who is a “Friend of FactoruM” or Full Member.

If you are a Friend of FactoruM, please bring your membership token with you, as this helps loads with reducing the costs of events. The less cost spent on table hire, means more can be invested in making events better in the future.

We will be playing the 10th Edition Warhammer 40,000 rules with the points and rules updates from the latest Grand Tournament Mission Pack.

Purge The Foe – Adapt or Die – Search and Destroy

Game 2

Terraform – Stalwarts – Crucible of Battle

Game 3

Linchpin – Raise Banners – Hammer & Anvil

Game 4

Scorched Earth – Hidden Supplies – Sweeping Engagement

Game 5

Burden of Trust – Inspired Leadership – Dawn of War

Missions are from the Chapter Approved Pariah Nexus Mission Deck. Be aware that some missions may have been changed by Games Workshop. The latest changes can be found on <https://www.Warhammer-community.com/>

You will be playing on different immersive tables with matching terrain and mats. The lay-outs are pre-set by Ginger Odin. All the terrain “buildings” are ruins and the windows and doors on all levels should be considered closed.

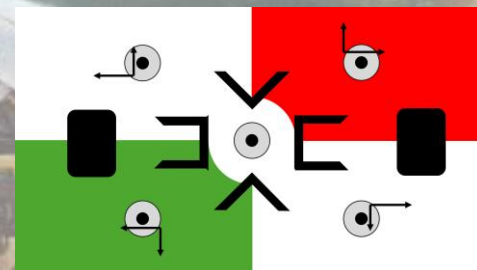
Terrain may vary due to the ongoing creation of additional tables and play testing. For consistency across all tables, all ruins should be considered over 4 inches tall.

To work out line of sight past ruins, draw a 1mm line from your model to your opponent’s model. If the model is completely blocked by the ruins base, you do not have line of sight. The only exception to this, is models with the “towering” keyword. Towering models should refer to the latest faq for towering rules.

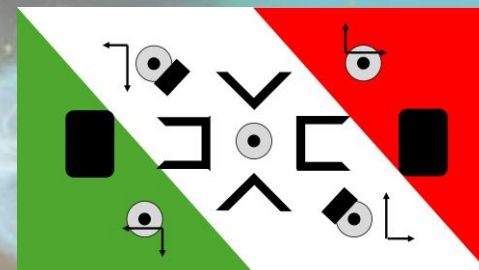
Table Layouts

Below are the table layouts that will be used for each mission. Players will use the diagrams to lay out the terrain, comparing them with the objectives on the mission cards. These diagrams are not to scale. Some terrain sets have larger ruins that others, which may cause the table to become more cluttered. Where this becomes an issue, call over a TO who will assist you. Large models like baneblades must be able to get to the central objective.

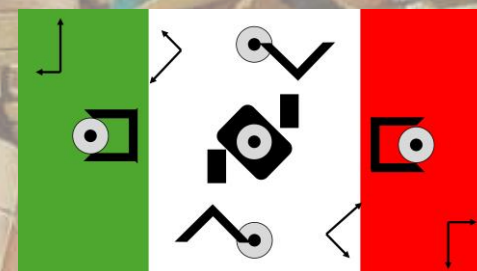

List Submission Deadline

Players must submit a legal 2000 point list.

The list submission deadline is Wednesday night before the event. All updates to rules after list submission will NOT be in use.

Army lists must be submitted to the Best Coast Pairings app, or website.

The event on BCP is called Ginger Odin Warhammer 40,000 GT September 2024.

If you struggle to submit your list to BCP, you must email gingerodinminiaturewargaming@outlook.com with your name, team and list.

Important Things to Note

Your list must be legal up to the limit of 2000 points.

We will not be using “Legend” units

Forge World units are allowed.

All pre-game strategems, powers, abilities, enhancements and warlord must be written on your list.

Model proxies are allowed, but must be approved by the organiser, by emailing the above email address.

All FAQ updates and erratas released on the Wednesday before the event will be used. Lists already submitted before the updates, must be reuploaded to include the new rules and or points. Failure to do this may result in disqualification.

Alex's Don't Be an Asshole Rule

Every event Ginger Odin Miniature Wargaming is supposed to be fun for everyone attending. All players will have spent money attending, so should have the best experience possible.

We are dedicated to creating a community of players who always attend events to have fun, and not focus on winning every game. So far, we have an amazing community that does just that.

Every event will follow the philosophy of "The aim of a game is to win, but the point is to have fun."



Warnings

Warnings may be given by the organiser and TO's if players don't follow the rules. Multiple warnings may be given at once for serious offenses.

Warnings can be given for the following. This is not an exhaustive list:

- Breaking the "Don't be an asshole rule"
- Arriving late to games.
- Submitting lists late, or not at all.
- Submitting illegal lists, or not playing with the list submitted.
- Running over time for games. (You will be given a chess clock next round.)
- Refusing to use a chess clock.
- Cheating (Repeatedly getting rules wrong, rolling the wrong dice, using weighted dice.
- Being disrespectful to the organiser, TO's, players, or FactoruM staff.

- If you are using a sub-faction, not included in this list, you will be eligible to win the faction of your parent codex. For example, Harlequins would play for the Aeldari prize.
